Resolution Approving Application of Northern Log Supply (Applicant) for an Industrial Facilities Exemption Certificate for a New Facility

WHEREAS, pursuant to P.A. 198 of 1974, M.C.L. 207.551 et seq., after a duly noticed public hearing held on December 16, 2008, this Village Council by resolution established the Mayville Industrial Development District No. 1; and

WHEREAS, Northern Log Supply has filed an application for an Industrial Facilities Exemption Certificate with respect to a new facility constructed within the Mayville Industrial Development District No. 1; and

WHEREAS, before acting on said application, the Village of Mayville held a hearing on January 19, 2010, at the Mayville Fire Department, 6044 Trend Street, Mayville, Michigan 48744, at 7:00 pm, at which hearing the applicant, the Assessor and a representative of the affected taxing units were given written notice and were afforded an opportunity to be heard on said application; and

WHEREAS, completion of the facility is calculated to and will at the time of issuance of the certificate have the reasonable likelihood to retain, create or prevent the loss of employment in the Village of Mayville; and

WHEREAS, the aggregate SEV of real and personal property exempt from ad valorem taxes within the Village of Mayville, after granting this certificate, will not exceed 5% of an amount equal to the sum of the SEV of the unit, plus the SEV of personal and real property thus exempted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY the Village Council of the Village of Mayville that:

1. The Village Council finds and determines that the granting of the Industrial Facilities Exemption Certificate considered together with the aggregate amount of certificates previously granted and currently in force under Act No. 198 of the Public Acts of 1974 and Act No. 255 of the Public Acts of 1978, shall not have the effect of substantially impeding the operation of the Village of Mayville, or impairing the financial soundness of a taxing unit which levies ad valorem property taxes in the Village of Mayville.

2. The application from Northern Log Supply for an Industrial Facilities Exemption Certificate, with respect to a New Facility on the following described parcel of real property situated within the Mayville Industrial Development District No. 1, to wit:

Commencing at the W ¼ corner, Section 25, T11N-R9E, Fremont Township, Tuscola County, Michigan. Thence S0°00'40"W 159.10 feet along the West Section Line, thence on a Curve to the Right 427.95 feet whose Long Chord Bears S80°18'44"E 427.72 feet, thence S0°00'40"W 108.58 feet to the Point of Beginning. Running Thence S89°59'20"E 180.00 feet, thence S0°00'40"W 242 feet, thence N89°59'20"W 180.00 feet, thence N0°00'40"E 242.00 feet to the Point of Beginning and containing 1.000 acre more or less.

3. The Industrial Facilities Exemption Certificate when issued shall be and remain in force for a period of 12 years.


