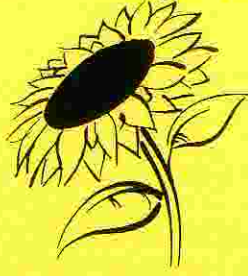

Police Services:

The Village Council voted 5-2 in favor of applying for the Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS) Program on March 17, 2009. This program is a competitive grant that if awarded would provide the village one (1) full-time officer free of charge for three (3) years. The village would have the obligation of sustaining the officer for 12 months following the three (3) year grant.

Trees:

The village was awarded a \$1,000 grant from the DTE Foundation to plant 300 White Cedar Trees and 300 Blue Spruce Trees at Ohmer Park. These trees will be planted in April of 2009. The purpose of the grant is to replace trees lost in storms at Ohmer Park in 2008 and to further beautify Ohmer Park.

***Road Information on Back**

Industrial Park Update:

The village would like to welcome our first business, Northern Log Supply, to the Mayville Industrial and Technology Community Development Park. The village is currently working with potential manufacturing facilities for the three (3) remaining sites. The Rural Task Force 7A awarded the village a \$50,000 grant for the Industrial Park Road which is scheduled for construction in Summer 2009. The Tuscola County Brownfield Redevelopment Authority awarded the village a \$1,500 grant for the environmental assessment required for federal grants. Total Industrial Park grants to date: \$71,500.

Fire Truck Update:

The village received the Kenworth 3,000 gallon pumper truck on February 24, 2009. Thank you to the Broken Teapot and the Mayville Chamber of Commerce for the outstanding meal. The 3,000 gallon tanker truck is scheduled to be delivered at the end of April 2009. Another community gathering will be scheduled and the meeting time will be posted in the Mayville Monitor closer to delivery.

Skatepark Update:

The village is holding a public hearing on April 21, 2009 at 7:00 pm at the Mayville Fire Department, 6044 Trend Street, Mayville, MI 48744. The purpose will be to receive public comment regarding a new site location being proposed north of the Arsenic Removal Plant on First Street.

Safe Routes to School Update:

The Michigan Department of Transportation will be bidding the Pine Street sidewalk project in May 2009. The sidewalk will start at Main Street and will end at the Mayville Elementary School passing Bodeis Park on the west side. The sidewalk will be concrete with dimensions of 5 ft wide and 6 inches thick meeting ADA requirements.

ROAD MILLAGE

Let's Talk...

The Village Council discussed at their regular meeting on March 17, 2009 placing a road ballot question on the next regular village election, September 15, 2009. The village has 4.762 miles of local roads and 2.725 miles of major roads (Fulton Street and Main Street). The village has applied for grant funding for Fulton Street and Main Street and these roads are scheduled to be resurfaced in 2013. Grant funding is currently not available for local roads.

Proposal:

- The village council will discuss placing a 2.0 road millage assessed on real property for ten (10) years on the ballot in September.
- The total taxable value on real property (not personal property) in the village is 17,002,145.
- The total revenue generated from this millage if passed over ten (10) years is \$340,043.
- Cost per Household: A household with a taxable value of \$50,000 would pay an additional \$100 per year. To figure out approximately what your yearly increase for this road millage will be:
 1. Find the 2009 Assessment Notice on your property (Notice of Assessment, Taxable Valuation, and Property Classification Form 1019) from the Fremont Township Assessor.
 2. On your 2009 assessment will be 1. TAXABLE VALUE, CURRENT AMOUNT YEAR: 2009.
 3. Take the 2009 Taxable Value, divide by 1,000, and multiply by \$2.
 4. This amount will be the increase to your tax bill for the road millage per year.

Example: 2009 Taxable Value = 50,000

$$50,000/1,000 = 50$$

$$50 * \$2 = \$100/\text{Year}$$

- A public hearing will be held on April 21, 2009 to receive public comment regarding this ballot question. The meeting will begin at 7:00 pm located at the Mayville Fire Department, 6044 Trend Street, Mayville, Michigan 48744.
