

OFFICIAL MINUTES OF VILLAGE COUNCIL MEETING
October 19, 2010

The Village Council of Mayville, Michigan held a Regular Meeting at the fire hall on October 19, 2010. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Clare Fryers, Village President, with the following officers and trustees present: Ray Whitaker, Brian Stout, Cheryl Piche', Cecilia Kapcia, Anthony Windham, Sam Reece and James Welke.

Public Comments –

- Cleo Porter- He stated that raising more taxes will cause Mayville to have less people.
- Jack Long- He stated no to raising the water bills and the council should make cuts.

Sunflower Festival- Cammie Asmus spoke to the council and told them she is the New President of the Mayville Sunflower Committee and requested the council make the Sunflower Committee an active committee of the Village Council. Moved by Reece, supported by Piche' to authorize the Mayville Sunflower Committee to be an active committee of the Village Council. Yes 7 No 0

Tuscola Economic Development Corporation- James McCloskey made a presentation to the council reporting the activities of the EDC in the Village of Mayville and Tuscola County. Moved by Whitaker, supported by Reece to authorize the payment of \$1200.00 to Tuscola County Economic Development Corporation for our yearly contribution. Yes 7 No 0

Approval of Minutes – Moved by Whitaker, supported by Kapcia to approve the minutes of the Regular meeting, September 21, 2010 as printed. Yes 7 No 0

Approval of Bills – Moved by Whitaker, supported by Reece to approve the payment of the bills as presented. Yes 7 No 0

Fire Department Report – The Fire Department report was given by Roger Sweet. He reported that the Fire Department had a successful soup supper of October 8, 2010.

Police Department Report – The Police report for September was reviewed with the council by Police Chief James Freeman.

Halloween Parade- Moved by Kapcia, supported by Whitaker to grant permission to the Mayville Elementary School for their Halloween Parade Friday, October 29, 2010 at 1:15 pm. Yes 7 No 0

Christmas Parade- Moved by Whitaker, supported by Kapcia to grant permission to the Mayville Lions Club to have a Christmas Parade for tree lighting on December 11, 2010 at 6:00 pm. Yes 7 No 0

Juvenile Problems- Moved by Kapcia, supported by Whitaker to have the Manager prepare a letter to be signed by council members to be submitted to the Probate Court System regarding problems with juveniles in the Village requesting from the court to have these juveniles receive more severe sentencing for repeat offenders. DPW Report –The DPW written report was available to the council in their meeting packets.

Pavement Repaired- Moved by Whitaker, supported by Stout to authorize the DPW Superintendent and Village Manager to have pavement repaired where water lines have been repaired at a cost not to exceed \$2000.00 Yes 7 No 0

Zoning Administration Report – The Zoning Administration Report was given by Clare Fryers. Zoning permits were issued to Bud Hall, 5 East Main St. A Public Meeting will be held on November 2, 2010 to consider a request from the Mayville Car Wash. DPW Superintendent will be checking on the gratings that have been installed by Marie’s Pizzeria to divert the water.

Manager Report- The written report prepared by the Village Manager was reviewed by the council. The Village Manager reviewed the following items for the council.

1. Michigan Municipal League Training- Training meetings are being held that are available for the council to attend. Council members were requested to contact the Manager if they would like to attend.
2. The Manager has had request from citizens who would like to take yard materials to the Lagoon. No decision was made at this time.
3. The Manager had request from individuals who would like to purchase some of the asphalt millings. No action was taken by the council.
4. A discussion was held concerning the individuals who have private wells. This was referred to the Village Manager to report back to the council.
5. Clerk-Treasurer Positions- The Village Manager will be sharing a memo to the council regarding these positions.
6. Fulton Street black topping should be completed by Thursday or Friday.

Water and Sewer Rates- Moved by Whitaker, supported by Reece to table the water and sewer rate increase and the committee will bring their recommendations back to council at the meeting next month. Yes 5 No 2

Treasurer- Judy Hartzell passed out materials to the council regarding the computer system used for the Property Tax Collection. The council will have to make a decision regarding this at a later meeting.

Committee Reports- The Park Committee reported on the Family Fun Day planned for October 23, 2010 at Bodeis Park.

Water Committee- Ray Whitaker discussed options available to the council to help reduce expenses in the water fund.

Rental Inspections- The Village employees are studying the possibility of having the Police Department do the rental inspections instead of contract that service.

Website- The Village Manager will review the Website that needs to be updated.
