**Downtown Development
Authority (DDA) News:**

The Mayville DDA awarded Complete Asphalt Paving Co. a contract to construct a storm sewer and to asphalt the Main Street Parking Lot, located directly east of the Windows 2 The Past Café. The contract is for \$23,995 and the work will be performed in October 2009. Some projects that are being discussed for 2010 include connecting the Fulton Street businesses to the Trend Street Parking Lot storm sewer system and paving the Trend Street Parking Lot.

Sewer Lagoon CLOSED To Public:

The Village of Mayville received DEQ Violation #VN-004053 on May 27, 2009 regarding the condition of the sewer lagoon, brush pile, and compost site. The village has spent over \$17,000 to meet DEQ regulations over the last several months. Brush and compost (grass and leaves) will be collected by the Village DPW on Mondays and Fridays. The village no longer picks up yard waste in plastic bags. Yard waste must be in paper bags, open containers, or wheel barrows. The public will not be allowed to enter the sewer lagoon and the Village Council closed the sewer lagoon at their September 15, 2009 regular meeting. The village has also posted notice that penalty for a dumping violation is a \$500 fine.

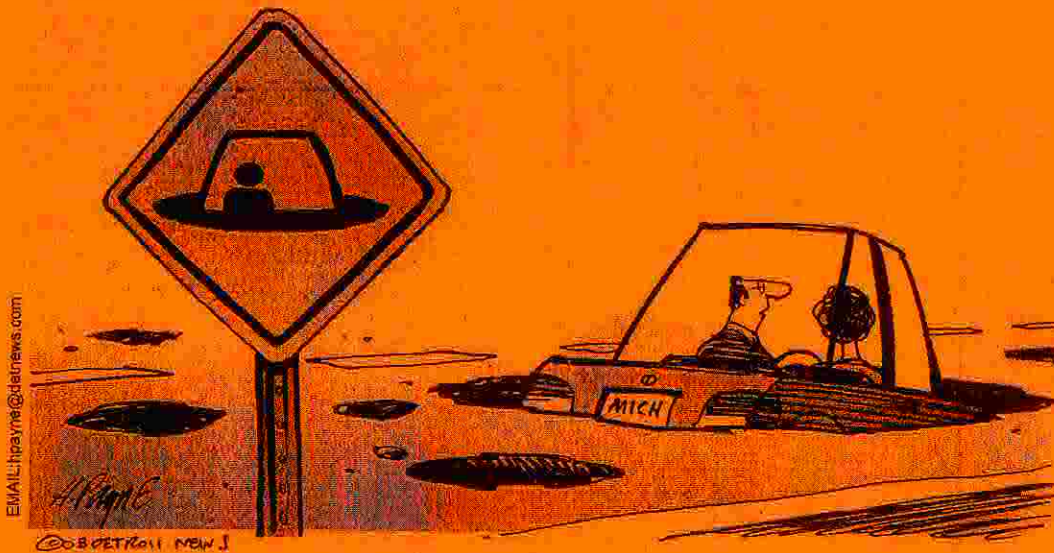

ROAD MILLAGE

What Happened?

The village placed a Road Millage on the ballot for the general election on September 15, 2009. The proposal was for two (2) mills over a ten (10) year period. A household with a taxable value of \$50,000 would have had a yearly increase of \$100 per year or \$8.33 per month. The finally tally was:
